

DPSF Privacy Policy

The Detroit Public Schools Foundation (“DPSF” or “We”) respects the privacy of individuals who visit www.dpsfdn.org (the “Website”). This policy explains how we collect, maintain, and use personal information that you provide to us or is otherwise collected through your use of the Website. Because your privacy is important to us, we provide you with notice and choices about the collection and use of your information. By visiting our Website, you accept the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

Information We Collect About You

- We may collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information by which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal information, email address, telephone number, and any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline (“personal information”); and
- We collect payment information, billing address and/or other information necessary to process a donation or event registration.

How We Collect Your Information

- If you request information via one of the email addresses identified on our website or otherwise contact us in person, by phone or email, with a question, we may then collect your name, address and email in order to respond to that inquiry.
- If you register for an event, we will collect your name, email address and other contact information.

We will not sell, share or trade your personal information with other entities without your permission. We may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide as described in this privacy policy:

- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our operation.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.

Children Under the Age of 13

This website is not intended for children under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you are under 13, please do not provide any information on this website.

How Long We Keep Information

DPSF keeps personal information for as long as we deem it useful to use, and for as long as applicable law allows us to maintain it.
